Season Continues with

Lucy McKenzie, Alan Michael, Bernie Reid and Markus Selg

Volcano Extravaganza 2013 is a summer season of art and design on the island of Stromboli taking place 26 July – 24 August 2013. Conceived by the Fiorucci Art Trust and curated by artist Lucy McKenzie and Milovan Farronato, this year's edition will comprise an eclectic array of talks, film screenings, exhibitions, fashion, dance, music and performance art at the House of Extravaganza and other locations on the secluded volcanic island.

The third annual Volcano Extravaganza takes inspiration from the 1982 film adaptation of Agatha Christie's novel Evil Under the Sun, a classic whodunit set on a private island in the Adriatic. Highlights later this week include:

August 16 – Lucy McKenzie and Alan Michael – For Volcano Extravaganza Lucy McKenzie and Alan Michael have produced Unlawful Assembly, a beachside paperback to divert the participants and visitors at the summer event. In the spirit of Agatha Christie's Evil Under the Sun, this is an anthology of detective stories by artists. As part of this collaborative writing project, artists have developed several separate stories to be presented in combination and contrast to each other.

August 17 – Markus Selg, artist and filmmaker, was a founding member of the experimental learning environment, Akademie Isotrop (1996 – 2000) and co-editor of Isotrop magazine. He is founder of publisher Possible Press and Giant Mountains Film. He recently completed his debut feature film Das Ewige Antlitz, which will have its premiere this year. For Volcano Extravaganza Selg will present various film projections.

The Fiorucci Art Trust was founded by Nicoletta Fiorucci in 2010 to promote contemporary art in both conventional and unconventional ways. With Milovan Farronato as Director, the Fiorucci Art Trust works across diverse platforms and disciplines to provide collaborative support for artist projects as well as publishing and exhibitions.
